Thanks also for your questions during the webinar. While we answered many in real-time, we were unable to get to all of them before the end of the hour. Please see our responses below:

**1. Can we order refill kit items a la cart?**

- a. All new equipment and materials have been added to the PLTW store. For consumable items, we recommend purchasing these from your own preferred suppliers, since it is a short list of items. Those items are:
  - i. LED Orange, 100PK 44PWEE510 1 Box 2 of 2
  - Fuse, 500mA, 5PK 44PWEE514 1 Box 2 of 2
  - LED Red, 5mm, 100PK 44PWEE511 1 Box 2 of 2
  - LED Blue, 5mm, 100PK 44PWEE500 1 Box 2 of 2
  - Hookup Wire, 100', Red 2700122RD 1 Box 2 of 2
  - Hookup Wire, 100', Black 2700122BK 1 Box 2 of 2
  - Hookup Wire, 100', White \* 2700122WH 1 Box 2 of 2
  - Plastic Cups, 16oz. (20PK) \* 44PWPOE21 1 Box 2 of 2
  - Fish Line \* 44PWPOE22 1 Box 2 of 2
  - Wood Glue, 4oz. (10PK) \* 44PWPOE23 1 Box 1 of 2
  - Food Color, 0.3oz. (4PK) \* 44PWPOE24 1 Box 2 of 2
  - “D” Cell Batteries \* 2800AKD 24 Box 1 of 2
  - Carbon Transfer Paper, 50PK \* 44PWPOE25 1 Box 2 of 2

**2. Can we download course materials as PDF?**

- a. While it is possible to download course materials as PDFs, PLTW recommends using the digital platform to ensure you are using the latest curriculum.

**3. For those that took Core Training last summer, will there be any updates available?**

- a. PLTW is currently evaluating opportunities to better support this transition.

**4. How do we administer the End of Course (EOC) assessment?**

- Both the legacy and updated POE courses will have End-of-Course (EOC) Assessments available.
- Students rostered for the legacy POE course will be eligible to take the EoC in spring 2024.
- Students rostered for the updated POE course will be eligible to take the EoC in Spring 2024.
- When we announced that the legacy POE course would be available for one more year, we provided guidance that students wishing to take an EoC should be rostered in POEL.
- The new EoC for POE will be reflective of the updates released on Dec. 22, 2023. We recognize this will present a challenge for new POE teachers and students who may not have worked through topics however, we hope that the webinar provided additional support for these new topics and encourage teachers to support one another through myPLTW community and by reaching out to Master Teachers.

- 5. Is there a new delivery system (not Inkling) for next year?**
  - a. PLTW Engineering will migrate to the new platform during the summer of 2025. All key dates and information about this migration can be found [here](#).
  
- 6. Have there been updates in the stress strain resource from Legacy POE?**
  - a. Yes, the legacy activity that is included in POE has been updated. Please reach out to our [Solution Center](#) if you have any specific curriculum questions.
  
- 7. Does anyone have a Canvas course (or assessment item bank, or practice worksheets, etc.) for the new curriculum?**
  - a. We encourage you to reach out to your Master Teacher or the Community for these types of resources.
  
- 8. Is there a timeline available for the new course?**
  - a. The Quick Guide at the beginning of every lesson in the Teacher Guide has a timeline for each activity, project, and problem in the course. Note that a “day” of instruction is considered 45 minutes, so you will need to adjust accordingly for block scheduling.
